

**COOPERATION AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
KALININGRAD STATE TECHNICAL UNIVERSITY, RUSSIA
AND
SUPORTNET AGRO AS**

Kaliningrad State Technical University (KSTU) and Suportnet Agro AS (SA) enter into the following terms of agreement in order to promote international cooperation education, science and technology.

Article 1

Both parties pledge themselves to cooperate in a spirit of greater understanding, to deepen friendly relationships and ties of mutual benefit and to foster collaboration between their staff and students. They undertake to initiate joint academic, research and business activities, such as:

- 1) to organize and perform joint research projects, academic seminars and guest lectures as well as to carry out industrial R&D projects;
- 2) to foster knowledge intensive entrepreneurship;
- 3) to organize European Union funding for joint research activities;
- 4) to exchange staff and students for perfection of language skills and professional abilities;
- 5) to exchange scholarly materials, research reports, publications, etc.;
- 6) to perform additional activities which might be separately agreed.

Article 2

Themes of joint activities, the conditions of utilizing the results achieved, arrangements for specific visits and exchanges and other forms of cooperation shall be agreed upon jointly for each specific case.

Article 3

Details of the cooperation, including the terms of research projects, the number of staff and students exchanged annually, terms of visits and finances shall be specified in an annual working-plan, composed of a detailed description of the planned activities and estimated costs.

In order to finance these exchange schemes, both parties should consider all possible source in their own countries and grants from outside.

Article 4

Both Parties shall nominate a contact person to ensure fulfilment of the terms of the Agreement. The coordinator shall ensure availability of all information necessary for the cooperation to the other party.

The coordinators shall be:

KSTU: Ass. Prof. Anatoly Zagorodny, Head of International Department

SA: Director Jonny Bunaes

Article 5

This cooperation Agreement is valid for five years from the date of the signing and may be extended by mutual written consent after the expiry date.

Both Parties reserve the right to modify or terminate the present Agreement before the expiry date by 60 days written notice, without prejudice and by mutual agreement. In the case of termination, programs already in progress shall be continued to an orderly conclusion.
